### Aim

- To ensure that outcomes (developed and disseminated) are adopted and implemented by target audiences, even after the end of the funding period
- ".... ensure that barriers to adoption are overcome and routes to exploitation are properly identified ....."



## **Objectives**

- Optimise project value, maximise achievements
- Develop/maintain exploitation plan
- Transfer project outcomes to relevant domains (network domains, educators)




### How?

- Work with WP leaders to identify exploitable results and develop plans
- Build contacts in stakeholder and partner organisations to understand how to use these results
- Investigate methods of providing outcomes for use, e.g. Open source (VLE, open access web facilities)
- Uptake How well have the results been used?




### Deliverables
