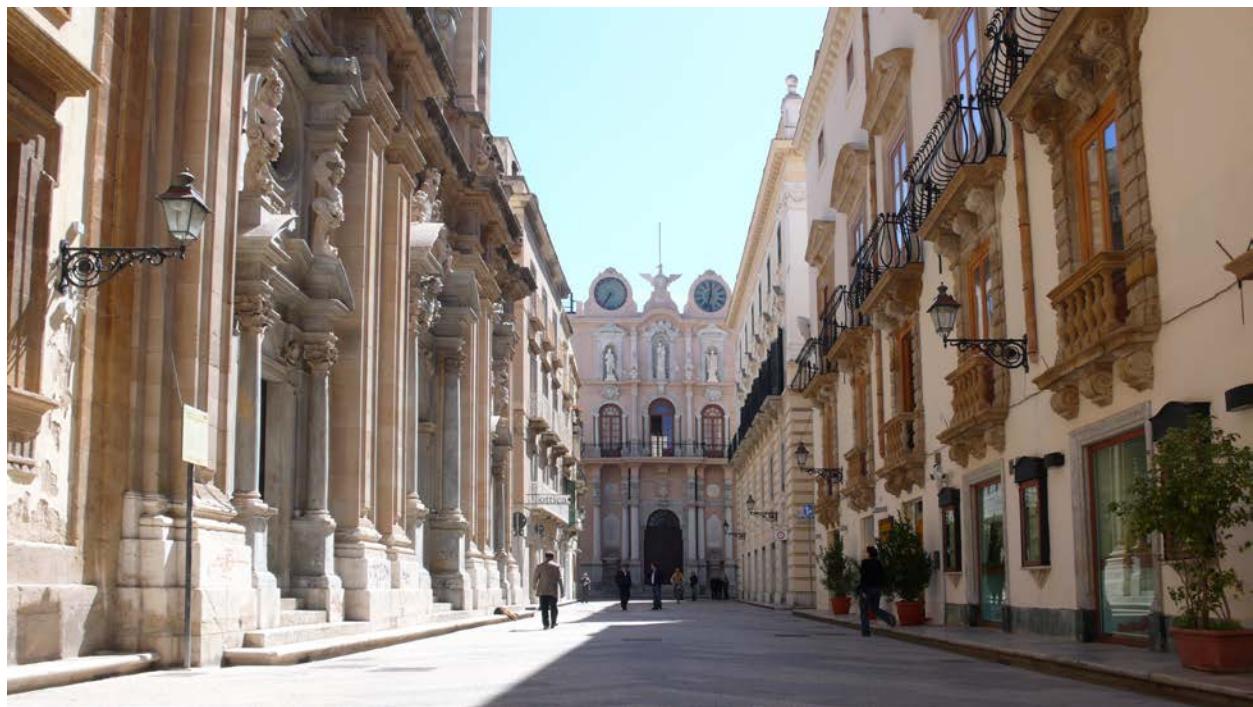

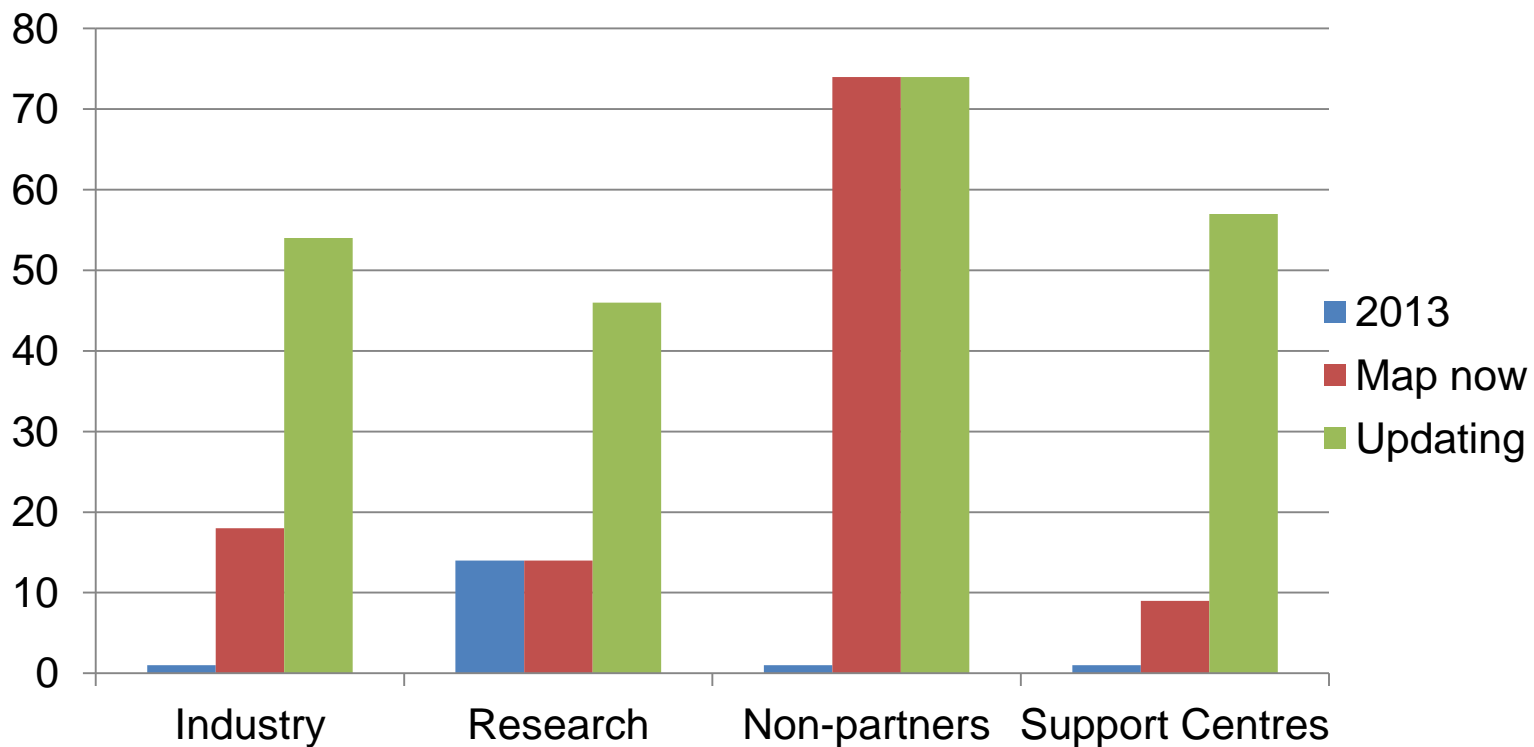

3.8 *Local points information package*

WP3 members find it unrealistic to develop a precise information package for each site under the AquaTnet, as it may constantly change depending on the local traits.

Nonetheless, we develop **a checklist** with a number of subjects and questions for movers to be monitored in specific local information sites.

This will be a check point in the Portal

- Financial issues (payment, taxes ...)

- Visas

- Cultural and religious issues. National and religious holidays,

- Working days and hours.

- Health/medical systems

- Travel insurance

- Consulate information

- Police information

- Accommodation



DL 3.9 Regional support

A number of regional/national points have now been identified regarding information, assessment and help on the aquatic sector.

About **20** new countries have been included in 2014 in the Regional Centers list

These will not appear in the map (too crowded), but the list will be available as a pop-up in the Portal

A number of **37** regional points are now available.



DL 3.10 Grants management

- We have collected as much grant information as possible on Aquatic Sciences
- The variety of grants is high and therefore we include the links to the sites in which the information is updated.
- The list will include not only aquatic related grants but other fields with relationship with the aquatic sector (biotechnology, environment, etc.).
- WP3 will provide two list of grants:
 - In the first list we include general and useful reference sites for grants in general (that you can browse).
 - In the second list we include the national and other specific grant sites
- This list will be also available in the Portal, organized as EU grants, national grants and International grants.



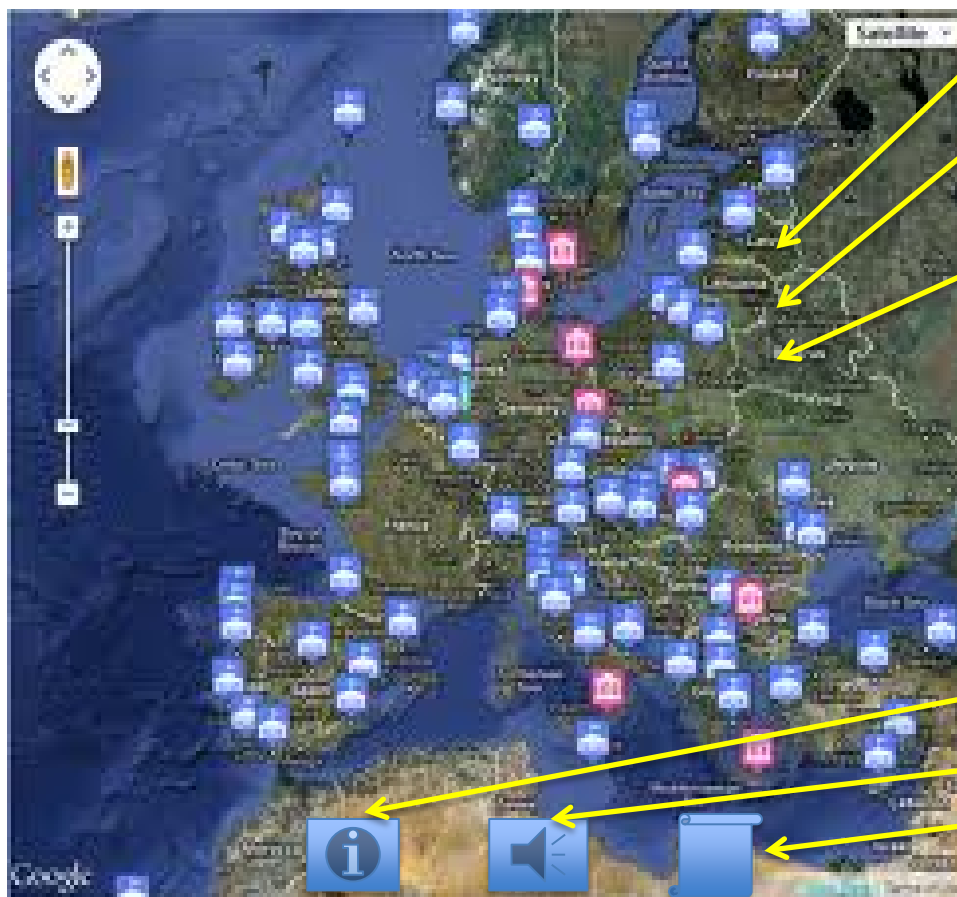
3.11 *Mobility reference site*

At the end of the project, WP3 will modify the current Portal /Education Gate to improve the current state in terms of completeness, clarity and usability.

The group also considered integrating other useful information in the Education Portal, such as jobs related to the Aquaculture, Fisheries and Aquatic Resource Management sectors. The PiscesTT initiative, already providing information for jobs, is an option that could appear in the portal.

- Good efforts to promote the Education Gate have been made but when you Google aquaculture and mobility the Aqua-tnet Education Portal does not come up in the search results on the first page and the group was wondering how to **promote the key words** and transparency of the name on google.
- In addition, we should make sure that more people are promoting it. **Links** with local regional and national support will help to promote the map.
- The group suggests **that research projects and research labs** of Aqua-tnet partners could insert a link with Aqua-tnet to increase visibility and promote impact, as it may be also good for the lab.
- Another suggestion is the development of an **App** for mobiles and other devices dealing with mobility information or services.
- Develop **Erasmus+** for mobility among AquaTnet members
