-Local Regional Support

Existing local/regional/national networks on aquaculture, fisheries, aquatic saciences or aquatic management can be very useful in helping mobility, both in contacting local institutions and providing information and eventually grants or other opportunities for movers.

There is also the idea of involving regional authorities to help in this regional support. This may end up with collaborative Initiatives to be proposed in the framework of aquaculture.

-Grants management: collating information

A work on collation information for grants will be undertaken and placed in the Portal where it will be available for students and movers. The list will include:

Listing EU grants (inside EU and with other world regions)

Listing other International grants

Listing National grants

Resources for grant help (institutions and webs)

Collating information

-Mobility Reference Site. Mobility Portal

The wp3 will continue to work on the design of the Portal and stressing the important items for its efficiency.

Another objective will be to publicize and include the reference site in institutions and relevant places in order to expand the exposure and connectivity of AquaTnet.

Action points

- 1) The attendants will try to find a way to assess whether the activity developed by the AquaTnet, and particularly the Mobility Portal, ends up with mobility actions, i.e. relationship between use of the Portal and real mobility
- 2) Introduce companies in the map, starting with bigger companies that may have more chances to, one, have mobility positions, two, interact through the Portal
- 3) Encourage the activity of members of countries that are under-represented in AquaT-net, in particular, France but also Germany or Poland.
- 4) To set meetings with stakeholders, specifically students, companies and research centers. Contacts have been already started with the EAS student group and specific companies.
- 5) Publisize AquaTnet-3 among other networks or organizations (Eurofish, ISMIR, ISAKI, PICAM, Aquaexcel, etc.)

- 6) Some improvements related to the appearance of the Portal were proposed and will be forwarded to the technical people. For instance it was proposed to place some key informations on the top of the portal (precise the type of mobility at the very beginning vocational, short course, lifelong learning...-, information packages, grants, internships).
- 7) It was agreed to contact with AquaTT to directly connect the PiscesTT service with the mobility Portal.
- 8) In the next weeks, the core group will organize itself to make the chronology and work distribution of the deliverables
- 9) It is intended to set the next core group meeting in Italy (possibly in Varese) around spring time 2013
