#### 1) Welcome and agenda

Apologies from different core members are acknowledged and the meeting received the visit of Gavin Burnell and Andrew Smith (wp9 quality insurance, internal and external evaluators), and Marieke Reuver (wp7 dissemination and outreach).

It is mentioned that the core meeting of the work package was held in the previous day of the venue in Malaga and therefore no significant changes will arise from that point.

#### 2) Overview of the WP3 duties and objectives

The attendants reviewed the duties included in the deliverables and particularly the specific deliverables 3.5 to 3.12 which involve the main workload of the work package, i.e., Course information package, expand mobility capacity, local contact points information package, local regional support, grants management: collating information, mobility Reference Site and the mobility portal.

This is the main content of the course information package that was determined in the core meeting group. As also accorded, other wps, specifically PhD and Masters (wp1, wp2) should feed their information in the AquaTnet information platforms and so coordinate the actions of all work packages of the AquaTnet project. Therefore wp3 should focus on other courses (vocational, life long learning, practical training, short visits).

#### *-Expand mobility capacity*

This deliverable deals with increasing opportunities for movers, therefore the wp3 will try to support all possible ways to encourage mobility, either through information, grants or contacts. The idea is also to involve national and regional organizations in aquaculture and aquatic sciences in supporting or helping mobility in and out

Actions that can be taken:

- Institutional networks exchanges

#### *-Local contact points information package*

A package regarding local information will be prepared and uploaded in the Portal to encourage local receivers to precise the useful or necessary information on the specific place, in particular about the location, accommodation, travel, insurance, etc. Some of these informations are listed below.

The information and the contents of the local point package will be available in the Portal and feed into the Portal map.

#### *-Local Regional Support*

Existing local/regional/national networks on aquaculture, fisheries, aquatic sciences or aquatic management can be very useful in helping mobility, both in contacting local institutions and providing information and eventually grants or other opportunities for movers.

There is also the idea of involving regional authorities to help in this regional support. This may end up with collaborative Initiatives to be proposed in the framework of aquaculture, fisheries and aquatic sciences.

#### *-Grants management: collating information*

A work on collation information for grants will be undertaken and placed in the Portal where it will be available for students and movers. The list will include:

- Listing EU grants (inside EU and with other world regions)

- Listing other International grants

- Listing National grants

- Resources for grant help (institutions and webs)

#### *-Mobility Reference Site. Mobility Portal*

The wp3 will continue to work on the design of the Portal addressing the important items for its efficiency.

Another objective will be to publicize and include the AquaTnet Portals end Site through institutions and relevant internet sites in order to expand the exposure and connectivity of AquaTnet.

#### 4.- Actions to be taken

- 1) The attendants will try to find a way to assess whether the activity developed by the AquaTnet, and particularly the Mobility Portal, ends up with mobility actions, i.e. relationship between use of the Portal and real mobility
- 2) Introduce companies in the map, starting with bigger companies that may have more chances to, one, have mobility positions, two, interact through the Portal
- 3) Encourage the activity of members of countries that are under-represented in AquaT-net, in particular, France but also Germany or Poland.
- 4) To set meetings with stakeholders, specifically students, companies and research centers. Contacts have been already started with the EAS student group and specific companies.
- 5) Publize AquaTnet-3 among other networks or organizations (Eurofish, ISMIR, ISAKI, PICAM, Aquaexcel, etc.)

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- 6) Some improvements related to the appearance of the Portal were proposed and will be forwarded to the technical people. For instance it was proposed to place some key informations on the top of the portal (precise the type of mobility at the very beginning – vocational, short course, lifelong learning...-, information packages, grants, internships).
- 7) It was agreed to contact with AquaTT to directly connect the PiscesTT service with the mobility Portal.
- 8) In the next weeks, the core group will organize itself to make the chronology and work distribution of the deliverables
- 9) It is intended to set the next core group meeting in Italy (possibly in Varese) around spring time 2013

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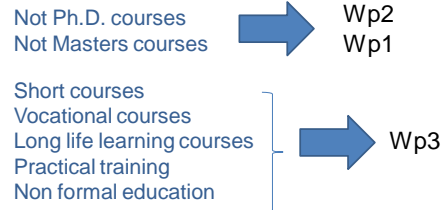

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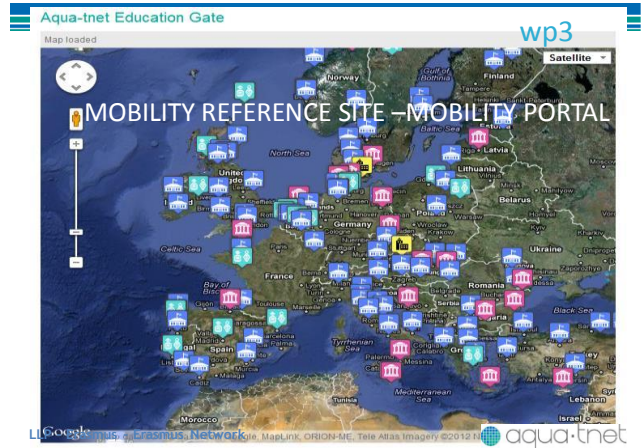
