RESEARCH PROJECT MANAGEMENT AUTUMN TRAINING WORKSHOP DUBLIN, IRELAND OCTOBER 22-24, 2013

With twenty-one years of experience in EC-funded research projects, AquaTT as part of its Mentoring, Training and Advisory Services has devised a robust three-day Research Project Management Training Workshop primarily aimed at Researchers and Communications and Project Officers.

This practical three-day training workshop provides participants with (i) an understanding of the lifecycle of EC-funded research projects, (ii) a skillset to increase their ability to efficiently project manage their work, and (iii) the opportunity to apply these skills to real issues that occur in research projects.

Over the course of the three days, experienced AquaTT trainers will guide participants through the various stages of a research project using real case studies and scenarios while simultaneously integrating the skillset to afford the participants practical experience of applying these skills to research projects.

This workshop is designed to facilitate a quality learning experience for groups in small numbers and is therefore open to a limited amount of participants.

The programme's customised interactive approach involves a combination of facilitated learning and practical exercises that will ensure participants experience hands-on learning to better prepare them to successfully manage EC-funded contracts.

DAY 1: SETTING THE SCENE

Day 1 provides a framework for the management of research projects from policy drivers during the application phase to internal relationships during the implementation phase.

- Introduction to Project Management & the Research Project Lifecycle
- The Funding Procurement Landscape - From FP7 to Horizon 2020
- Managing Professional Relationships - Introduction to Internal Project Communications

DAY 2: SKILL-BASED LEARNING

Day 2 will allow participants to work on real case studies building upon the knowledge they acquired during the first day's sessions. The topics in Day 2 will equip the participant with the knowledge and skills to understand the key challenges involved in project and financial management. Participants will learn about project-based relationship management, including dealing with project partners and other stakeholders, promoting their own projects, and effectively expanding their own professional network at external events.

- Understanding Project Applications and Budgets
- External Communications Management (I) - Building your Network
- External Communications Management (II) - Event Management and Participation

DAY 3: APPLIED PROJECT MANAGEMENT AND PROJECT SUSTAINABILITY

Day 3 focuses on the essential tools that will increase each participant's capacity to successfully manage a research project while taking into consideration key issues, including performance measurement of project outputs and outcomes. The programme will conclude with an exploration of how to achieve and maintain success in the EC-funded research project environment.

- Risk Management in Projects – from Time Management to Stakeholder Facilitation
- Value Creation – Demonstrating Impact from Your Project
- Maintaining Success in a Competitive External Funding Environment – The Way Forward
