# WP5: Innovative lifelong learning

## Sub-group B: Lifelong Learning (LLL)

Presented by *Kim Jauncey*

- To ensure that the outcomes of aqua-tnet 3 are framed in the context of current EU thinking with respect to the Lifelong Learning agenda (itself a complex and multifaceted thing).

# What is the scope of sub-group B?

- The primary focus has been on curricular frameworks that underpin LLL in our discipline area.
- The intention was for this to result in updating of the 'Tuning' template draft developed in an earlier aqua.tnet project. However, 'Tuning' has been changing over the course of this project.
- Alongside this, sub-group B has been summarising relevant parts of wider LLL developments and interpreting them for network members. More of this will be accomplished and disseminated in the forthcoming 'Special Issue'.

# Tuning

- Details of the Tuning Academy (hosted by the University of Deusto and the University of Groningen) can be found here:

- Deusto and Groningen act as “European Tuning Information and Counselling Centres (ETICCs)”
- 33 countries have Tuning Information Points (TIPs) listed in the Tuning Academy.
- It is unclear whether (and how) new subject areas can be added to the list of those ‘Tuned’.
- As well as the, largely historical, resources of the Tuning Academy, they have also set-up a biannual Tuning Journal:

- 2 issues have been published (Nov 2013, May 2014) each of which contains a wealth of relevant articles.



# Lifelong Learning

- There has already been considerable discussion in this meeting of various relevant components of Lifelong Learning.
- With Erasmus+ and discussion of the future of the aqua-tnet project LLL is going to be an important focus.
- 5B will make a final attempt to summarise the current relevant EU context.
- Significant work was done by the SIRUS (**S**haping **R**esponsive and **I**nclusive **S**trategies) and ALLUME (**A** Lifelong **L**earning **U**niversity **M**odel for **E**urope). Both projects finished in 2012.
